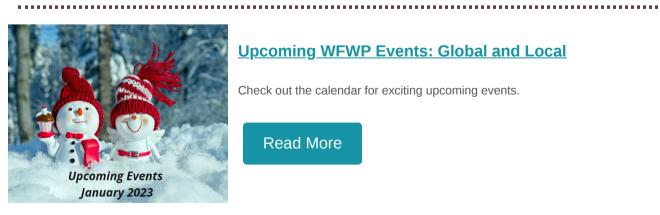
TIPS TO STAY HEALTHY AND WELL
