

HEALTH TIPS FROM THE MAYO CLINIC Good Things to Know (Second of a Two-Part Series) Dr. Virend Somers is a Cardiologist from the Mayo Clinic who is the lead author of the report in the July 29, 2008 issue of the Journal of the American College of Cardiology. Here is some advice from him about heart attacks. Most heart attacks occur in the day, generally between 6 A.M. and noon. 
