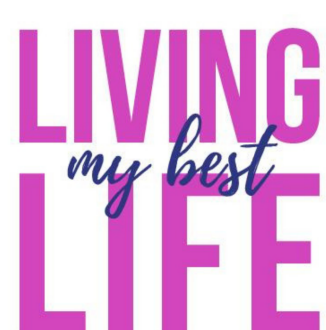


## UPLIFT, COLLABORATE, TRANSFORM: WFWP USA NORTHEAST AND MIDWEST LEADERSHIP RETREAT
