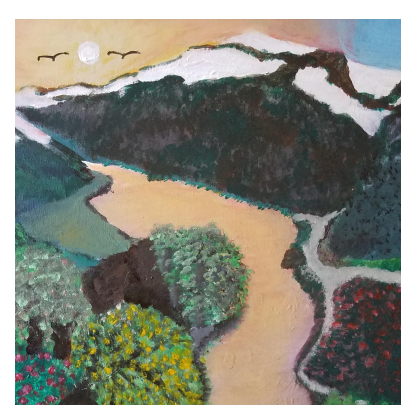
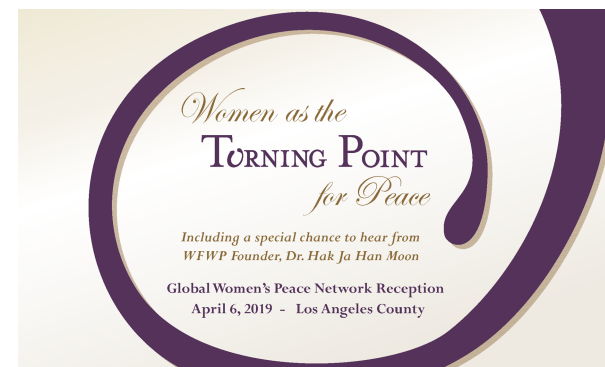


SAVING LIVES: FIREFIGHTERS SPEAK AT WFWP GATHERING IN HACKENSACK, NJ

and the sound of love throughout



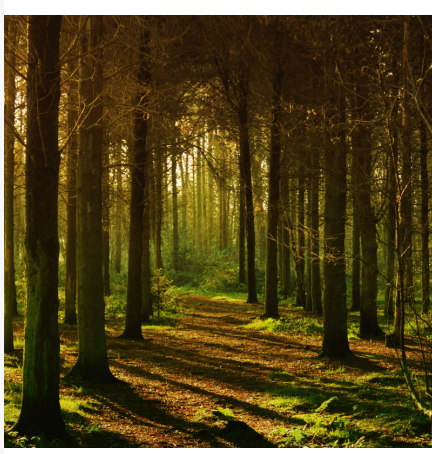
LEARNING TO DE-STRESS: WFWP SEATTLE EXPERIENCES THE POWER OF MUDRAS
